## Sample Masonic Withdrawal Letter #1

## Gentlemen:

Before entering the Lodge, I was asked if I believed in a Supreme Being. My answer was "Yes". Now, however, after much prayer and study, I believe that the god behind the rituals of Freemasonry is not the God I must obey. My God is the Father of Jesus, the Christ, who came to earth in the form of a man to die for me that I might live eternally with Him. My Father says, "I am the Lord thy God...Thou shalt have no other gods before me."

In my ignorance concerning Masonry's true god, I have sworn to many things that are totally against my Father's Word, the Holy Bible. I am now convinced that Freemasonry is in no way compatible or complementary to Christianity, therefore, I present to you this, my *Petition for Withdrawal*.

I hereby confess the Lord Jesus Christ as both Lord and Savior in my life. I renounce my association with and all obligations to Freemasonry.

It is with love and concern for present Freemasons that I do this. We have all been deceived through the rituals as the writer of them, Albert Pike, 33°, said we were supposed to be (Morals & Dogma, pg. 819). I have no ill feelings or any animosity whatever toward you or any other man in the Lodge. It is not you who deceived me, it was the upper echelons; the Thirty-Third Degree [Masons], who know the true designs and purposes of Freemasonry who have deceived us. I pray that you too will search out the truth, for when you do, you will find that you must come out from among them and be not unequally yoked together with unbelievers (those who do not believe in Jesus Christ).

True Christians cannot keep these satanic oaths. God's Word teaches us that if we make a sinful oath, we must confess it to Him and ask His forgiveness. He will forgive us and remember that sin no more! Jesus said that whoever committeth sin is the servant of sin. But when we know the Truth (Jesus is the Truth!), the Truth shall make you free.
